BENSON PRIMARY SCHOOL AGREES TO:

- Adhering to the Birmingham BSCB (Birmingham Safeguarding Children's Board) with regard to referring a child if there are concerns about possible neglect or abuse.

WE, AS A FAMILY AGREE TO:

- Ensure my child attends school promptly every day, where possible. When my child is absent we will notify the school on the first day of absence.
- Make sure my child arrives at school for 8:40 am and is collected promptly at 3.15 pm.
- Attend a meeting at school to discuss any pupil leave of absence requests.
- Ensure that any holiday is taken outside of school term time.
- Ensure my child wears the correct school uniform and has the appropriate P.E. and swimming kit.
- Support the school rules and expectations on behaviour.
- Support the school by ensuring my child participates in a broad and balanced curriculum including educational visits.
- Encourage my child in reading, homework and other opportunities for home learning.
- Attend Parent's Evenings, discussions and meetings related to my child's progress at school.
- Talk to teachers if my child is worried about school or if something happens that might affect their work or behaviour.
- Discourage my child from swearing and correct them if they do swear.
- Educational visits. This is a crucial element of the curriculum provision. My child will attend these visits including educational visits to places of worship.
